 9am – 4pm – Wednesday 5th April to Sunday 9th April 2017

• CHECK IN at: Derby Town Hall – 84 Main Street, Derby

(Corner of Krushka & Main Street)

- You will be allocated your own site number, if you didn't indicate you wanted to be near friends, please let us
 know ASAP and we will try and accommodate as best we can. We ask that you please stay within your allocated
 site area as the campsite is fully booked.
- The sites are grass only, please be careful driving in (especially heavy vehicles i.e Motorhomes etc)
- Please note there is only one car per campsite
- Remember to please keep your valuables safe at all times
- Note: If you cannot check in at this time please contact us ASAP, thankyou

CHECK OUT:

- CHECK OUT will be: Monday 10th April 2017 If you wish to remain in Derby longer please relocate to the Council Camping area which is 19 Main Street, Derby.
- Please ensure you leave your campsite and grass area the way you found it. All rubbish must be disposed of in the bins provided.

SPEED LIMIT - Please note the speed limit through the campsite is: 8KM/H (Walking pace only)

CHILDREN - Patrons are responsible for their own children at all times. Young children **MUST** be accompanied by an adult when using the amenities

AMENITIES — Portable hot showers and toilets will be available. Please be considerate of your fellow campers and also the environment when using the facilities (please keep water usage to a minimum). Children MUST be accompanied by an adult. Hand basins are NOT to be used to bath children or wash dishes.

QUIET TIME — Please be considerate of your fellow camping neighbours and keep loud noise to a minimum. All loud noise MUST cease from 10pm til 8am. NO noise after midnight. Undue noise and inconsiderate behaviour in any form is NOT permitted. Abusive language or excessive noise will NOT be tolerated at any time.

GARBAGE/DUMP POINTS - Bins will be available throughout the camping grounds, however please note there is **NO** sewage disposal. The nearest sewage dumping point is available at Scottsdale (30 minutes away) and St Helens (1 hour away).

POWER — Please be mindful of power usage and please do not use in excess. (e.g especially large motorhomes)





BIKE WASHING — Bike washing is **not permitted** at the campsite however you are able to wash your bike at the public bike wash area located behind "**Crank It**" Café at 55 Main Street, Derby.

WATER - IMPORTANT - BOIL ALERT DO NOT DRINK WATER FROM PUBLIC OR ACCOMMODATION TAPS

- BOIL all water from taps
- Tasmania Water will be providing fresh water at Little Rivers Brewing Village and the Official EWS Campsite. So please refill from these water supplies.
- Buy bottled water on route to Derby at Scottsdale, or Branxholme and the local Derby Cafés

ANIMALS/PETS

- Dogs are permitted Please be mindful of your fellow campers and keep pets with you at all times.
- Your dog must be supervised at all times and never left unattended inside or outside your van/annex or tent.
- Dog owners are 100% responsible for picking up and disposing of their dog's or pets waste in a plastic bag into the General Rubbish Bins about the Park.

VISITORS - ALL guests and visitors must comply with park rules

INTOXICATION/UNLAWFUL ACTS - Excessive use of alcohol is an unacceptable condition of stay. Violence, use of illegal drugs, theft, vandalism, abuse (physical or verbal) will NOT be tolerated. Please understand it will be our duty to notify the police and will result in the termination of your stay.

EVACUATION PROCEDURE - In the event of an emergency an evacuation area will be at the Entry of the camping grounds.

PERIMETER — For your own safety please do not pass the perimeter of the campsite and do not climb any surrounding fences.



WHAT TO BRING (OPTIONAL)

- Folding chairs
- Camp stoves/cooking equipment
- Please use extension leads (for powered sites) that are tested/tagged
- Refillable water containers
- Torch
- FYI Personal Campfires are <u>NOT PERMITTED</u> we need to keep our beautiful environment safe ⁽³⁾
- Waterproof gear
- Be prepared for wet and cold conditions
- Raise your bedding off the ground, including your personal belongings
- Expect noise bring earplugs ☺ Even the tent zippers are noisy! Especially in the serenity of Derby. ☺

- 2. What happened
- 3. Nature of injuries
- 4. Are you with them
- 5. Age of injured person
- 6. Are they conscious?
- 7. Are they breathing?

Snakes

Welcome to Australia and our beautiful critters. In the unlikely event you do come across a snake we highly recommend you have a compression bandage on your person at all times. It's highly unlikely you'll see one and even more unlikely that you'll get bitten. This could save your life.

A compression bandage (and staying still and calm) are the two best assurances that you will, if bitten, live. *(Information to the right)* Memorise. And carry the damn bandage. Because dying by snake bite is way more annoying than having to carry a bandage.

Management

- 1. Follow DRSABCD.
- 2. Rest and reassure the patient.
- 3. Apply a broad pressure bandage
 - (preferably crepe) over the bite site as soon as possible.
- 4. Apply a pressure immobiliation bandage
 - apply a firm heavy crepe or elasticised roller bandage
- start just above the fingers or toes, and move upwards on the limb as far as can be reached (include the snake bite)
- apply tightly without stopping blood supply to
- 5. Splint the bandaged limb.
- 6. Ensure the patient does not move.
- 7. Write down the time of the bite and when the bandage was applied
 - stay with the patient.
 - check circulation in fingers or toes.
